Who are we?

- We are the largest dedicated grant funder of the UK's heritage.
- As The National Lottery Heritage Fund, we distribute National Lottery grants from £3,000 to £5million, funding projects that sustain and transform the UK's heritage.
- We provide leadership and support across the heritage sector, and advocate for the value of heritage.
- We fund projects that connect people and communities to heritage

What is heritage?



Heritage can be anything from the past that you value and want to pass on to future generations.

Heritage can include;

- History of people and communities or places and events
- Oral history
- Cultural traditions
- Nature
- Community archaeology
- Historic buildings, monuments and environments
- Collections of objects, books or documents in museums, libraries or archives
- Heritage of languages and dialects
- Places and objects linked to our industrial, maritime and transport history

The money you get for your project can be used for:

- Activities to engage the wider community in your heritage.
- Repairs and conservation
- Digital outputs
- New staff posts
- Paid training placements
- Professional fees



Our mandatory outcome - Inclusion



Outcomes are changes, impacts or benefits that happen as a direct result of your project. All projects must achieve our mandatory outcome - a wider range of people will be involved in heritage, this can be done by:

- Addressing under-representation in heritage
- The range of people benefiting from heritage will be more diverse than before your project started
- Thinking about your local area and identifying gaps of people who are not involved with your organisation
- Benefiting people who have never engaged with heritage before
