Through four main programme areas – education, world of work, sport and play, and health and wellbeing – we use the power of football to engage individuals and groups, to increase life opportunities and to develop happier, healthier and more cohesive communities. Recognised as one of the leading football charities in the country, we raise over £4million each year through community and corporate fundraising, as well as funding support provided by a range of public and private bodies.



- Applied to the National Lottery Heritage Fund started in February 2021
- After a positive project enquiry, we went to full application requesting a grant of £247,300.00
- The application had to have an organisational contribution of £30,000 which was achieved by match funding.
- Told successful in August 2021
- Completed ready to start documents in August 2021

'COALS TO GOALS' - 142 YEARS OF SUNDERLAND AFC

- 'Connect': Through weekly heritage-based interventions which bring communities together, including older people at risk of loneliness, those living with dementia, and those on low incomes.
- 'Learn': Inspiring children to learn about the history of Sunderland and its relationship with the football club through a contextualised education programme that supports improvements in subject areas such as literacy and numeracy.
- 'Take Notice': Installing an interactive timeline within the stadium footprint that takes people on a journey through Sunderland AFC's history.
- 'Give': Empowering local people, including young people unemployed, to lead activities as Heritage Ambassadors.
- 'Be Active': Using heritage as a catalyst to inspire physical activity, from guided heritage walks to progression pathways into other activities offered by Foundation of Light.









Recruitment of a Project Manager and Activation Officer (both full time).



Delivery of a school education programme; children will learn about the history of Sunderland and the football club through heritage learning opportunities, supporting improvements in literacy, numeracy and citizenship

Delivery of heritage interventions to bring communities closer together, including older people at risk of loneliness and those living with dementia. Sessions will include winter health sessions and whole family learning opportunities.

Delivery of a volunteer programme empowering local people, including unemployed youths, to lead activities as 'Heritage Ambassadors'. Volunteers will be trained and support the delivery of education activities and lead heritage walks around the Stadium of Light site.





Development of a heritage based work-readiness programme focused on up-skilling young people aged 18-24 who are NEET (not in education, employment, or training). Young people will be supported to access work placements with partners, gain employability qualifications and progress into employment.

Delivery of a media programme to encourage Sunderland fans to donate their own memorabilia and oral histories

Development and installation of a community developed interactive heritage timeline within the stadium footprint about Sunderland AFC's history.

Undertake the measures to increase positive environmental impacts and reduce negative environmental impacts as set out in your application.

High visibility acknowledgement of the National Lottery Heritage Fund on site, online and in all activities. As well as using your project to acknowledge and thank National Lottery Players.
